TAX RETURNS UNIFORMLY MADE PUBLIC (TRUMP) ACT

TAX RETURNS UNIFORMLY MADE PUBLIC ACT (the TRUMP Act):

Proposed NY State legislation to require presidential and vice presidential candidates to release their income tax returns.

Candidates who do not comply would be disqualified from being on New York's ballot. Electoral College members in NY would not be allowed to vote for a candidate that does not submit tax returns.

Crucial information to assess a candidate who is a possible leader of our country should not be denied to voters.

NY State Senator Brad Hoylman sponsors the legislation and stated:

“For over four decades, tax returns have given voters an important window into the financial holdings and potential conflicts-of-interest of presidential candidates. Voters deserve to know that personal priorities will never take precedence over the national interest.”

Therefore be it resolved:

The Downtown Independent Democrats support the TAX RETURNS UNIFORMLY MADE PUBLIC ACT (the TRUMP Act) which requires that presidential and vice presidential candidates submit their tax returns as a requirement to be on the ballot in NY State.
